Playing with DSO

DSO performs a variety of music, from significant works of the orchestral canon, to film music, rock and pop arrangements, and new Australian works.

In a calendar year, DSO typically performs 6 concerts, with 5 weeks of rehearsals beforehand. A yearly schedule is released towards the end of the previous year.

Rehearsal and Performance Requirements

- Rehearsals are Monday 6:15pm 9:15pm at Purple 5, Casuarina Campus, Charles Darwin University Ellengowan Drive, Brinkin NT.
- Concerts are typically on a Saturday evening.
- In a concert week, an additional rehearsal on a Friday evening is required. Musicians are also required for other occasional weekend workshops.

Assessment and Trial Period

We welcome enquiries from players who wish to join Darwin Symphony Orchestra, and enjoy involving many people in the Darwin music community in our rehearsals and performances.

The Artistic Director/Chief Conductor and relevant Principal Musician will assess your application to decide on your suitability for the orchestra.

When a place is available in the orchestra, you will be invited to a rehearsal. A trial period of up to 3 rehearsals will enable the Artistic Director/Chief Conductor and the relevant section Principal as to suitability for the orchestra.
